There's a lot going on as we get ready for graduation and I wanted to make sure you were informed of the dates and deadlines below.

June 10 Senior grades are due at 5pm, this is a hard CPS deadline. Students not passing graduation requirements by 5pm on June 10 will not be able to graduate.

June 11 Lockers cleaned out and books returned! Fees for lost or damaged items will be accounted for and added to the amount required to receive diploma materials.

→ **Caps and gowns will be distributed at graduation practice, so don't miss it!**

June 12 AM: Classes as usual (West Campus)
PM: Graduation practice in the auditorium during Block 4

→ **Special Honors and awards will be distributed at graduation practice, so don't miss it!**

June 13 Block 1-3, Classes as usual (West Campus)

Senior Final Assembly during block 4. Students will go over expectations for graduation, verify their post-secondary plans, pay any outstanding debts, etc. Students are required to be at school all day but practice will take place during block 4.

→ **Graduation Tickets will be distributed at the Final Assembly, so don't miss it! Each student will receive seven graduation tickets.**

June 14 **Students do not need to come to school**

Graduation, 6:30pm-8pm at Park Community Church, 1001 N. Crosby Ave. Parking is available at the church. Overflow parking is available at Jenner if needed. The ceremony is on the 2nd floor of the church. The elevator is located in the parking garage connected to the church and handicap accessible seating is available.

Students must arrive no later than 6:00pm to get lined up and ready to walk. Doors will open for ticketholders at 6:00.

Seniors, please wear dress shoes, and at least "business casual" attire (dress pants and collared shirt, or a professional dress).

Families, we want graduation to be a special day for everyone. Please do not bring air horns or other noisemakers, glitter or confetti. Please do not bring balloons or other large items. There is no space for those items in the auditorium, and you will have to leave them outside.

June 17 Diploma pickup at West Campus, 1250 W. Erie, 9am-11am. Students will pay any outstanding fees before picking up their diplomas.
