Students must have 95% attendance for 4<sup>th</sup> quarter April 17<sup>th</sup> to June 19<sup>th</sup> to participate.

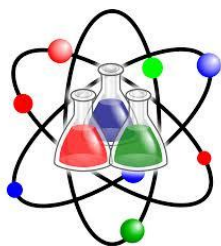


## SPRING FASHION SHOW-
