

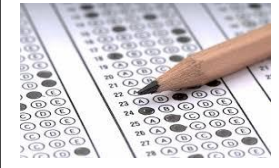

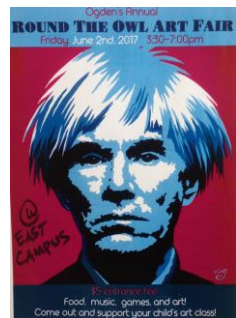
The Commencement Ceremony will take place @ Harvest Bible Chapel At 915 N. Dearborn St. at 2:30 PM. (4 tickets per student)
