OPEN LUNCH POLICY- For the 2017-2018 school year, students in 11th and 12th grade may qualify for open campus lunch by filling out the Open Campus Lunch Application found in the main office or online at www.ogden.cps.edu Attendance and grades from the 4th quarter of 2016-2017 will be used to determine first quarter eligibility. To qualify, students must meet the following criteria:

- Students must maintain an overall **96% attendance** average at school in order to earn/maintain open lunch privileges. If a student drops below the 96% attendance threshold, their privilege will be revoked for the remainder of the quarter.
- Students must have fewer than 5 tardies to school for any reason, within a quarter to earn/maintain open lunch privileges.
- Students must have fewer than 10 cumulative tardies across all classes within a quarter to earn/maintain open lunch privileges.
- Students who have a grade below a C for the academic quarter will not be eligible to apply for open campus lunch for the next quarter.

OPPORTUNITIES

SUICIDE PREVENTION- The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline is a national network of local crisis centers that provides free and confidential emotional support to people in suicidal crisis or emotional distress 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There are warning signs that may help determine if a loved one is at risk for suicide.

If you or someone you know exhibits any of these, seek help by calling the Lifeline or by speaking to a counselor:

- Talking about wanting to die or to kill themselves; -Looking for a way to kill themselves;
- Talking about feeling hopeless or having no reason to live; -Talking about feeling trapped or in unbearable pain; -Talking about being a burden to others; -Increasing the use of alcohol or drugs; - Acting anxious or agitated; -Behaving recklessly; -Sleeping too little or too much; -Withdrawing or isolating themselves;
- Showing rage or talking about seeking revenge; - Having extreme mood swings
