OGDEN ART FAIR

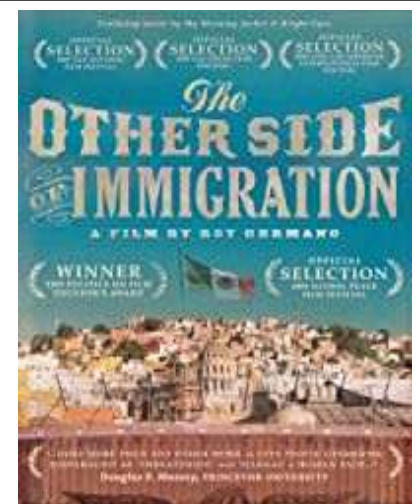
The Round the Owl Art Fair will take place at the East Campus on Friday, June 2nd from 3:30 to 7:00.
