REGISTRATION AND PICTURE DAY- On August 28th, anytime between 12:00 pm and 6:00 pm all incoming students in grades 6-12 are to report to the West Campus to complete critical registration forms, pay fees, receive their class schedule, obtain lock and locker assignments, and to take their school picture which will also be used for their school ID card. Parents are invited to attend with their student and should anticipate the registration process taking approximately 90 minutes.
